Key points:

1. Mouth closed.
2. Ears laid back.
3. Half moon eye.

Firkin is saying, "I am very concerned about what you are going to do to me, please go away".

**X DANGEROUS**

Key points:

1. Dog on chair.

It is dangerous for a child to approach a dog that is on a chair or other furniture.

**X DANGEROUS**

Key point:

1. Dogs playing with stick.

Clipper and Savannah are playing tug-of-war with a stick. They may bite by accident or on purpose if someone tries to take the stick away from them.

**X DANGEROUS**

Key points:

1. Mouth closed.
2. Dog has toy.
3. Dog on blanket.
4. Ears forward.
5. Direct stare.

Lola is saying, "Don't come any closer to my toy".

**X DANGEROUS**

Key points:

1. Dog in car.

Dogs in cars should never be approached by a child. The dog's teeth are at face level and the dog may bite to protect the car.

**X DANGEROUS**

Key points:

1. Dog in crate.

Sammy is saying, "I am very worried. Please leave me alone". Stay away from dogs in crates.
