Key points:
1. Boy hugging dog.

Dogs do not like to be hugged. Pet the dog on the side of his neck or under his chin instead.

✓ SAFE

Key points:
1. Adult supervision.
2. Dog doing trick.

Blitz is showing off his "waving" trick and learning to obey a child.

SEE-SEE-SEE-IT

✓ SAFE

Key points:
1. Adult supervision.
2. Playing frisbee.

This is a safe game as long as the dog gives the frisbee back without trying to play tug-of-war.

Key points:
1. Agility training with dog.
2. Adult supervision

Gala is having fun jumping through a hoop. This is a fun and safe activity. This dog is very intent on her work and should not be petted while she is busy.

Key Points:
1. Dog jumping up.

Dogs should not be encouraged to jump up.

SEE-SEE-SEE-IT

✓ SAFE

Key Points:
1. Adult supervision.
2. Dogs not interacting with kids.
3. Dogs and kids calm.
4. Known dogs.
