



**SEE-SEE-SEE-IT**

**X DANGEROUS**

Key points:

1. Mouth closed.
2. Ears forward.
3. Tail held high.

Sam is saying, "I demand that you throw the ball now". Do not try to approach a dog that is showing this type of body language.

**SEE-SEE-SEE-IT**

**✓ SAFE**

Key points:

1. Panting.
2. Eyes relaxed.
3. Ears relaxed.

Sam is saying, "I am feeling relaxed and happy".

**SEE-SEE-SEE-IT**

**X DANGEROUS**

Key points:

1. Licking chops.
2. Ears back and sideways.

Blucher is saying, "I'm uncomfortable with what you are doing. Please stop".

*Note to parents: This is example of displaced behaviour (licking chops when there is no food) see parent guide at doggonecrazy.ca for more information.*

**SEE-SEE-SEE-IT**

**X DANGEROUS**

Key points:

1. Strange dog.
2. No adult supervision.
3. Loose dog.

Stay away from strange dogs, even if they look friendly.

**SEE-SEE-SEE-IT**

**✓ SAFE**

Key points:

1. Panting.
2. Ears and body relaxed.
3. Adult supervision.

Shelby is saying, "I am relaxed".

**SEE-SEE-SEE-IT**

**X DANGEROUS**

Key points:

1. Mouth closed.
2. Leash tight.

Shelby is saying, "I'm not too sure about you".
